Honest

Providing for honest things, not only in the sight of the Lord, but also in the sight of men. (2Co 8:21 KJV)

Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men. (Rom 12:17 KJV)

Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by *your* good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation. (1Pe 2:12 KJV)

Just

But a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, just, holy, temperate; Tit 1:8 KJV

Pure

Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. (Tit 2:14 KJV)

This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in *both* which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance: (2Pe 3:1 KJV)

And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure. (1Jn 3:3 KJV)

Lovely

His mouth *is* most sweet: yea, he *is* altogether lovely. This *is* my beloved, and this *is* my friend, O daughters of Jerusalem. (Son 5:16 KJV)

Good Report

For by it the elders obtained a good report. (Heb 11:2 KJV)

Abstain from all appearance of evil. (1Th 5:22 KJV)

Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil. (1Ti 3:7 KJV)

Virtue

According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. (2Pe 1:3-4 KJV)

For this very reason, adding your diligence [*to the divine promises*], employ every effort in exercising your faith to develop virtue (excellence, resolution, Christian energy), and in [*exercising*] virtue [*develop*] knowledge (intelligence), (2Pe 1:5 AMP)

Praise

Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee. (Heb 2:12 KJV)

By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of *our* lips giving thanks to his name. (Heb 13:15 KJV)

And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both small and great. (Rev 19:5 KJV)
