

# In the Beginning God

Act 10:38 KJV How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Luk 4:18 KJV The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

<sup>H3068</sup> -self Existent or eternal / *yeh-ho-vaw'*

<sup>H430</sup> -gods (the plural form a singular word) *el-o-heem'*

Psa 91:14-16 KJV Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. (15) He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. (16) With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

Psa 90:1 KJV A Prayer of Moses the man of God. Lord, thou hast been our dwelling place in all generations.

Psa 90:10 KJV The days of our years are threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years, yet is their strength labour and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away.

Gen 6:3 KJV And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

# Man after the fall of Adam and Eve

Eph 2:12 KJV **That at that time ye were without Christ**, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world:

Rom 1:28 KJV And even as they did not like to retain God **in their knowledge**, **God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;**

1Co 10:19-21 KJV What say I then? that the idol is any thing, or that which is offered in sacrifice to idols is any thing? (20) But *I say*, that **the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God**: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils. (21) Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of **the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.**

Gal 4:8 KJV Howbeit then, when ye knew not God, ye did service unto them which by nature are no gods.

1Th 4:5 KJV Not in the lust of concupiscence, even as **the Gentiles which know not God**:

1Co 2:14 KJV But the natural man receiveth not the things of **the Spirit of God**: **for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.**

# Salvation In Christ Jesus

Col 3:3 KJV For ye are dead, and your life is hid **with Christ in God.**

Col 2:3 KJV In whom are hid all the treasures of **wisdom and knowledge.**

1Pe 1:23 KJV Being born again, not of corruptible seed, **but of incorruptible, by the word of God,** which liveth and abideth for ever

1Jn 3:9 KJV **Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin;** for his seed remaineth in him: and **he cannot sin,** because **he is born of God.**

1Pe 2:24 KJV **Who his own self bare our sins in his own body** on the tree, that **we, being dead to sins,** should live unto righteousness: **by whose stripes ye were healed.**

Mat 8:17 KJV That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, **saying, Himself took** our infirmities, **and bare** our sicknesses.

Eph 3:9 KJV And **to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:**

Col 1:27 KJV To whom God would make known what *is* the riches of **the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:**

\*\*\*Eph 3:10-12 AMP [*The purpose is*] **that through the church the complicated, many-sided wisdom of God in all its infinite variety and innumerable aspects might now be made known to the angelic rulers and authorities (principalities and powers) in the heavenly sphere.** (11) **This is in accordance with the terms of the eternal and timeless purpose which He has realized and carried into effect in [the person of] Christ Jesus our Lord,** (12) **In Whom, because of our faith in Him, we dare to have the boldness (courage and confidence) of free access (an unreserved approach to God with freedom and without fear).**

Col 1:13 KJV Who **hath delivered us** from the power of darkness, and **hath translated us into the kingdom** of his dear Son:

Eph 2:6 KJV And **hath raised us up** together, and **made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:**

Col 3:1-3 KJV **If ye then be risen** with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. (2) Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. (3) For **ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.**

Heb 9:15 KJV And **for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament,** that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions *that were* under the first testament, **they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.**

Heb 5:9 KJV And being made perfect, **he became the author of eternal salvation** unto all them that obey him;

1Pe 1:18-20 KJV **Forasmuch as ye know** that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, *as* silver and gold, from your vain conversation *received* by tradition from your fathers; (19) **But with the precious blood of**

**Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: (20) Who verily was fore **ordained before the foundation of the world**, but was manifest in these last times **for you**,

1Jn 3:9 KJV Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

1Pe 4:3-4 KJV **For the time past of our life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the Gentiles**, when we walked in lasciviousness, lusts, excess of wine, revellings, banquetings, and abominable idolatries: (4) Wherein **they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you**:

# A life Out of Balance

## The dangers of religion!

Gal 4:9-12 AMP

(9) *Now, however, that you have come to be acquainted with and understand and know [the true] God, or rather to be understood and known by God, how can you turn back again to the weak and beggarly and worthless elementary things [of all religions before Christ came], whose slaves you once more want to become?* (10) *You observe [particular] days and months and seasons and years!* (11) *I am alarmed [about you], lest I have labored among and over you to no purpose and in vain.* (12) *Brethren, I beg of you, become as I am [free from the bondage of Jewish ritualism and ordinances], for I also have become as you are [a Gentile]. You did me no wrong [in the days when I first came to you; do not do it now].*

### Example

Mat 6:33 KJV *But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.*

Eph 1:3 TLB (3) *How we praise God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every blessing in heaven because we belong to Christ.*

1Co 3:21-23 KJV (21) *Therefore let no man glory in men. For all things are yours;*

(22) *Whether Paul, or Apollos, or Cephas, or the world, or life, or death, or things present, or things to come; all are yours;* (23) *And ye are Christ's; and Christ is God's.*

(2Pe 1:2 KJV) *Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and*

*of Jesus our Lord, (2Pe 1:3 KJV) According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:*

Mar 3:28 KJV *Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme:-----*

Luk 8:13 KJV *They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away.*

***If you take the time to study the following Scriptures, you will never be deceived by religion or religious false teachings. All things are lawful for you but all things do not build you up or strengthen You.***

Gal 4:9-10 KJV ***But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?*** (10) ***Ye observe days, and months, and times, and years.***

Gal 4:9-11 AMP ***Now, however, that you have come to be acquainted with and understand and know [the true] God, or rather to be understood and known by God, how can you turn back again to the weak and beggarly and worthless elementary things [of all religions before Christ came], whose slaves you once more want to become?*** (10) ***You observe [particular] days and months and seasons and years!*** (11) ***I am alarmed [about you], lest I have labored among and over you to no purpose and in vain.***

1Co 6:12 KJV All things are lawful unto me, **but** all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, **but** I will not be brought under the power of any.

1Co 6:12 AMP Everything is permissible (allowable and lawful) for me; **but** not all things are helpful (good for me to do, expedient and profitable when considered with other things). Everything is lawful for me, **but** I will not become the slave of anything or be brought under its power.

1Co 10:23 KJV All things are lawful for me, **but** all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, **but** all things edify not.

1Co 10:23 AMP All things are legitimate [permissible--and we are free to do anything we please], **but** not all things are helpful (expedient, profitable, and wholesome). All things are legitimate, **but** not all things are constructive [to character] and edifying [to spiritual life].

## ***A Circumspect Life Build On Self Effort***

*Mat 7:26-27 KJV* And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto **a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand:**

*(27)* And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.

*Luk 6:49 KJV* But he that heareth, and doeth not, is **like a man that without a foundation built an house upon the earth;** against which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell; and the ruin of that house was great.

*Mar 4:16-17 KJV* And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness; *(17)* And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, **when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.**

# A Circumspect Life Build On The Word Of God!

Eph 5:15 KJV See then that **ye walk circumspectly**, not as fools, but as wise,

Mat 7:24-25 KJV Therefore **whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man**, which built his house upon a rock: (25) And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

Exo 23:13 KJV And **in all things that I have said unto you be circumspect**: and make no mention of the name of other gods, neither let it be heard out of thy mouth.

Jas 1:21-25 KJV Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and **receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.**

(22) But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

(23) For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: (24) For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. (25) But **whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.**
